

Lubricating Eye Drops

HYPROMELLOSE 0.3%

Soothes irritated and dry eyes

Composition: Hypromellose 0.3% w/v, sodium chloride, potassium chloride, borax, boric acid, benzalkonium chloride, water for injection.

Intended Use: Treatment of mild, occasional or temporary forms of dry eye: the soothing, moisturising and lubricating qualities of Ocufresh Lubricating Eye Drops provides effective and long lasting relief from the ocular discomfort and irritation associated with dry eyes, tiredness and environmental factors such as wind, salt water, smoke or computer work.

Target population group: The target disorders can affect both genders and all age groups although chronic dry eyes occur more commonly in the elderly.

Dosage and Frequency of use: Instil one or two drops into the affected eye(s) by gently squeezing the bottle. Use as required for relief of symptoms up to 4 times daily.

Duration of treatment: Do not continuously use for more than 30 days.

Consult a doctor if use is required for more than 4 times daily or more than 30 days.

Precautions and Warnings:

- Do not use in case of eye infection, injury or corneal abrasion.
- Do not use if the bottle is damaged.
- Do not use if you are allergic to any of the ingredients listed above.
- Do not use after the expiry date shown on the pack.
- Do not touch the eye with the tip of the bottle.
- Leave at least 10 minutes between the administration of these eye drops and any other

eye medicine.

- Discard the contents 30 days after opening.
- Keep out of reach and sight of children.
- This product is to be used only by the concerned user; it should not be shared with others.
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- Do not swallow.
- Do not store above 25°C.
- Keep the bottle in the outer carton to protect from light and moisture.
- If the problem does not improve within 2 days or worsens at any time, consult your doctor.
- Consult your doctor if you are pregnant or breast-feeding.
- Benzalkonium chloride may be absorbed by soft contact lenses and may change the colour of the contact lenses.
- You should remove contact lenses before using this product and put them back 15 minutes afterwards.
- Benzalkonium chloride may also cause eye irritation especially if you have dry eyes or disorders of the cornea.
- If you feel abnormal eye sensation, stinging or pain in the eyes after using this product, talk to your doctor.

Possible side effects:

This product may cause:

- Mild burning sensation in the eye.
- Temporary blurring of vision. Do not drive or operate machinery until normal vision is restored.
